REGULATIONS OF EXHIBITION – ABRIDGED

Subject to Amendment, Addition or Deletion by the Committee at any Committee Meeting.

ENTRIES

1 All Entries must be made on Entry Form supplied, to the Secretary, and must be lodged, together with the necessary fees, with the Secretary at the Office not later than the Closing Time set out in the particular Section or Class.

5 All Exhibits must be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor or the Firm or Company he/she represents at the time of Entry and at the time of Exhibition, unless otherwise

expressed in the Schedule.

8 The Committee shall always have the right to reject, cancel, move or remove any Entry or Exhibit without giving any reason for doing so and without incurring any liability thereon.

14 No Exhibit shall be removed before 4.00 p.m. on the last day of the Show without

the permission of the Secretary unless otherwise stated.

15 The Association will not be responsible for any accident caused through or by any Exhibit and each Exhibitor shall indemnify the Association and its Committee from and against all claims, demands and costs arising out of or in connection with any accident to or by his or her exhibit.

EXHIBITORS

18 Exhibitors shall, if required, furnish a Statutory Declaration as to the bona-fides of their Exhibit, and all prize-money of such Exhibitors may be with-held until three weeks after the submission of the declaration.

19 The Decision of the Judge or Judges appointed by the committee of the Association

shall be final and without appeal.

27 JUDGES AND STEWARDS ONLY shall be in the Pavilion until completion of the Judging therein.

PROTESTS

31 All protests against an Exhibit or Award must be in writing, fully setting out the grounds of the protest and must be lodged with the Secretary before 5 p.m. on the day the Award is made, accompanied by a fee of \$10 which will be forfeited to the Association if the Committee deems the protest frivolous.

Local events are for those residing within 20km of Manildra or own a business/farm within that area. Champions (except led) cannot compete again in same ring or other ring. Horses ARE NOT permitted to enter both hacking and hunter classes at this show. A show hunter is for hacks, ponies or Galloways 3yrs of age or over. This class has been created for the horse with a bit more substance than perhaps seen in general classes, but it is expected to demonstrate the ability to provide a smooth even ride and reliable temperament. It should exhibit sound conformation and be free from hereditary defects and unsoundness and, like all good show horses, exhibit excellent quality and class.


